Could fund a lab technician for 1 day. Lab technicians are crucial to the running of the lab, ensuring researchers are equipped with everything they need to beat cancer.



Could pay for a patient's cancer biopsy, where a tiny amount of tumour is removed with a needle to be studied in the lab.



Buys special chemicals called antibodies, which light up tiny parts of cancer cells, helping shed light on new ways to beat cancer.



Research assistants carry out vital experiments in the lab, helping us to find the next breakthrough in cancer research. £1000 could fund a research assistant for 2 weeks (£520 for 1 week).





Buys a 3D printer, which our scientists can use to invent new and bespoke pieces of equipment that don't exist in the lab. This helps our scientists carry out ground-breaking experiments to help us beat cancer.





Helps Professor Willie Hamilton and researchers looking at the accuracy, cost, effectiveness and suitability of a range of diagnostic tests used in GPs surgeries. Hopefully this will not only shorten the waiting time for diagnosis, but also reduce patients' anxiety.
